Instead of loving the Trinity of God (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit), we tend to love a different trinity: Me, myself, and I.



One of the main roles of the Holy Spirit in our lives is to help us understand the Bible. Jesus said, "Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come" (John 16:13).

Spirit of God / the Lord / Christ: (Matthew 3:16; 2

Corinthians 3:17; 1 Peter 1:11) These names remind us that the Spirit of God is indeed part of the triune godhead and that He is just as much God as the Father and the Son. He is first revealed to us at the creation, when He was "hovering over the waters," denoting His part in creation, along with that of Jesus who "made all things" (John 1:1-3). We see this same Trinity of God again at Jesus' baptism, when the Spirit descends on Jesus and the voice of the Father is heard.
