This is a bit of an SOS and I really hope you don't mind me reaching out to you. After many years of hard labour, our commercial tumble dryer at the **Freedom Centre** was finally condemned on Friday and our washing machines are also on their last legs. So there is an urgent need for us to invest in our laundry facilities and the current fund raising environment is very challenging. As you can imagine, we are using this equipment on a daily basis with at least 4 loads a day to clean and dry: We are in the early stages of determining exactly what equipment we need, but it is very clear this will amount to **well over £5000**. If you feel able to help us raise the money we need to replace the laundry equipment through a one off donation, we would be so grateful and blessed. Please ask for donation details.
